The Bible Wine Definition Test

Using the '5th Rule: Rule of Non-Contradiction' from 'The Seven Golden Rules of Bible Interpretation'.

All 236 matches, spanning 216 verses in 44 books of the Bible, for the word 'wine', 'wines', 'winebibber', and 'winebibbers' have been checked to label each verse as wine spoken of as Positive (56), Negative (54), or Neutral/Unknown (106). See the resultant 'The Bible Wine Test Chart' document.

(Genesis 9:21 KJV) And he drank of the wine, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent.

Negative

(Genesis 9:24 KJV) And Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done unto him.

Negative

(Genesis 14:18 KJV) And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

Positive

(Genesis 19:32 KJV) Come, let us make our father drink wine, and we will lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father.

Negative

(Genesis 19:33 KJV) And they made their father drink wine that night: and the firstborn went in, and lay with her father; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

Negative

(Genesis 19:34 KJV) And it came to pass on the morrow, that the firstborn said unto the younger, Behold, I lay yesternight with my father: let us make him drink wine this night also; and go thou in, *and* lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father.

Negative

(Genesis 19:35 KJV) And they made their father drink wine that night also: and the younger arose, and lay with him; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

Negative

(Genesis 27:25 KJV) And he said, Bring *it* near to me, and I will eat of my son's venison, that my soul may bless thee. And he brought *it* near to him, and he did eat: and he brought him wine, and he drank.

Neutral/Unknown

(Genesis 27:28 KJV) Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:

Positive

(Genesis 27:37 KJV) And Isaac answered and said unto Esau, Behold, I have made him thy lord, and all his brethren have I given to him for servants; and with corn and wine have I sustained him: and what shall I do now unto thee, my son?

Positive

(Genesis 49:11 KJV) Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

Positive

(Genesis 49:12 KJV) His eyes shall be red with wine, and his teeth white with milk.

Positive (Note: It appears this may mean he has so much wine, that he is full up to the top of his eyes with wine, and he has so much milk his teeth are white like milk. In other words, this verse seems to be referring to great prosperity. We know that your teeth don't turn white from drinking a lot of milk, so we can possibly infer that this verse is not referring to the effect alcoholic wine has on the eyes when drunk in excess.)

(Exodus 29:40 KJV) And with the one lamb a tenth deal of flour mingled with the fourth part of an hin of beaten oil; and the fourth part of an hin of wine *for* a drink offering.

Positive

(Leviticus 10:9 KJV) Do not drink wine nor strong drink, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: *it shall be* a statute for ever throughout your generations:

Negative

(Leviticus 23:13 KJV) And the meat offering thereof *shall be* two tenth deals of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto the LORD *for* a sweet savour: and the drink offering thereof *shall be* of wine, the fourth *part* of an hin.

Positive

(Numbers 6:3 KJV) He shall separate *himself* from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

Negative

(Numbers 6:20 KJV) And the priest shall wave them *for* a wave offering before the LORD: this *is* holy for the priest, with the wave breast and heave shoulder: and after that the Nazarite may drink wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Numbers 15:5 KJV) And the fourth *part* of an hin of wine for a drink offering shalt thou prepare with the burnt offering or sacrifice, for one lamb.

Positive

(Numbers 15:7 KJV) And for a drink offering thou shalt offer the third *part* of an hin of wine, *for* a sweet savour unto the LORD.

Positive

(Numbers 15:10 KJV) And thou shalt bring for a drink offering half an hin of wine, *for* an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

Positive

(Numbers 18:12 KJV) All the best of the oil, and all the best of the wine, and of the wheat, the firstfruits of them which they shall offer unto the LORD, them have I given thee.

Positive

(Numbers 28:7 KJV) And the drink offering thereof *shall be* the fourth *part* of an hin for the one lamb: in the holy *place* shalt thou cause the strong wine to be poured unto the LORD *for* a drink offering.

Positive

(Numbers 28:14 KJV) And their drink offerings shall be half an hin of wine unto a bullock, and the third *part* of an hin unto a ram, and a fourth *part* of an hin unto a lamb: this *is* the burnt offering of every month throughout the months of the year.

Positive

(Deuteronomy 7:13 KJV) And he will love thee, and bless thee, and multiply thee: he will also bless the fruit of thy womb, and the fruit of thy land, thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep, in the land which he sware unto thy fathers to give thee.

Positive

(Deuteronomy 11:14 KJV) That I will give *you* the rain of your land in his due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil.

Positive

(Deuteronomy 12:17 KJV) Thou mayest not eat within thy gates the tithe of thy corn, or of thy wine, or of thy oil, or the firstlings of thy herds or of thy flock, nor any of thy vows which thou vowest, nor thy freewill offerings, or heave offering of thine hand:

Positive

(Deuteronomy 14:23 KJV) And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

Positive

(Deuteronomy 14:26 KJV) And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household,

Positive

(Deuteronomy 16:13 KJV) Thou shalt observe the feast of tabernacles seven days, after that thou hast gathered in thy corn and thy wine:

Positive

(Deuteronomy 18:4 KJV) The firstfruit *also* of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the first of the fleece of thy sheep, shalt thou give him.

Positive

(Deuteronomy 28:39 KJV) Thou shalt plant vineyards, and dress *them*, but shalt neither drink *of* the wine, nor gather *the grapes*; for the worms shall eat them.

Neutral/Unknown

(Deuteronomy 28:51 KJV) And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which *also* shall not leave thee *either* corn, wine, or oil, *or* the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

Neutral/Unknown

(Deuteronomy 29:6 KJV) Ye have not eaten bread, neither have ye drunk wine or strong drink: that ye might know that I am the LORD your God.

Neutral/Unknown

(Deuteronomy 32:33 KJV) Their wine is the poison of dragons, and the cruel venom of asps.

Negative

(Deuteronomy 32:38 KJV) Which did eat the fat of their sacrifices, *and* drank the wine of their drink offerings? let them rise up and help you, *and* be your protection.

Neutral/Unknown

(Deuteronomy 33:28 KJV) Israel then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob *shall be* upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

Positive

(Joshua 9:4 KJV) They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

Neutral/Unknown

(Joshua 9:13 KJV) And these bottles of wine, which we filled, were new; and, behold, they be rent: and these our garments and our shoes are become old by reason of the very long journey.

Neutral/Unknown

(Judges 9:13 KJV) And the vine said unto them, Should I leave my wine, which cheereth God and man, and go to be promoted over the trees?

Positive

(Judges 13:4 KJV) Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean *thing*:

Negative

(Judges 13:7 KJV) But he said unto me, Behold, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and now drink no wine nor strong drink, neither eat any unclean *thing*: for the child shall be a Nazarite to God from the womb to the day of his death.

Negative

(Judges 13:14 KJV) She may not eat of any *thing* that cometh of the vine, neither let her drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean *thing*: all that I commanded her let her observe.

Negative

(Judges 19:19 KJV) Yet there is both straw and provender for our asses; and there is bread and wine also for me, and for thy handmaid, and for the young man *which is* with thy servants: *there is* no want of any thing.

Positive

(1 Samuel 1:14 KJV) And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

Negative

(1 Samuel 1:15 KJV) And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

Negative

(1 Samuel 1:24 KJV) And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with three bullocks, and one ephah of flour, and a bottle of wine, and brought him unto the house of the LORD in Shiloh: and the child *was* young.

Positive

(1 Samuel 10:3 KJV) Then shalt thou go on forward from thence, and thou shalt come to the plain of Tabor, and there shall meet thee three men going up to God to Bethel, one carrying three kids, and another carrying three loaves of bread, and another carrying a bottle of wine:

Neutral/Unknown

(1 Samuel 16:20 KJV) And Jesse took an ass *laden* with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent *them* by David his son unto Saul.

Neutral/Unknown

(1 Samuel 25:18 KJV) Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched *corn*, and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid *them* on asses.

Neutral/Unknown

(1 Samuel 25:37 KJV) But it came to pass in the morning, when the wine was gone out of Nabal, and his wife had told him these things, that his heart died within him, and he became *as* a stone.

Negative

(2 Samuel 6:19 KJV) And he dealt among all the people, *even* among the whole multitude of Israel, as well to the women as men, to every one a cake of bread, and a good piece *of flesh*, and a flagon *of wine*. So all the people departed every one to his house.

Positive

(2 Samuel 13:28 KJV) Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amnon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous, and be valiant.

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Samuel 16:1 KJV) And when David was a little past the top of the hill, behold, Ziba the servant of Mephibosheth met him, with a couple of asses saddled, and upon them two hundred *loaves* of bread, and an hundred bunches of raisins, and an hundred of summer fruits, and a bottle of wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Samuel 16:2 KJV) And the king said unto Ziba, What meanest thou by these? And Ziba said, The asses *be* for the king's household to ride on; and the bread and summer fruit for the young men to eat; and the wine, that such as be faint in the wilderness may drink.

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Kings 18:32 KJV) Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil olive and of honey, that ye may live, and not die: and hearken not unto Hezekiah, when he persuadeth you, saying, The LORD will deliver us.

(1 Chronicles 9:29 KJV) *Some* of them also *were* appointed to oversee the vessels, and all the instruments of the sanctuary, and the fine flour, and the wine, and the oil, and the frankincense, and the spices.

Positive

(1 Chronicles 12:40 KJV) Moreover they that were nigh them, *even* unto Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, brought bread on asses, and on camels, and on mules, and on oxen, *and* meat, meal, cakes of figs, and bunches of raisins, and wine, and oil, and oxen, and sheep abundantly: for *there was* joy in Israel.

Neutral/Unknown

(1 Chronicles 16:3 KJV) And he dealt to every one of Israel, both man and woman, to every one a loaf of bread, and a good piece of flesh, and a flagon of wine.

Positive

(1 Chronicles 27:27 KJV) And over the vineyards was Shimei the Ramathite: over the increase of the vineyards for the wine cellars was Zabdi the Shiphmite:

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Chronicles 2:10 KJV) And, behold, I will give to thy servants, the hewers that cut timber, twenty thousand measures of beaten wheat, and twenty thousand measures of barley, and twenty thousand baths of wine, and twenty thousand baths of oil.

Positive

(2 Chronicles 2:15 KJV) Now therefore the wheat, and the barley, the oil, and the wine, which my lord hath spoken of, let him send unto his servants:

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Chronicles 11:11 KJV) And he fortified the strong holds, and put captains in them, and store of victual, and of oil and wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(2 Chronicles 31:5 KJV) And as soon as the commandment came abroad, the children of Israel brought in abundance the firstfruits of corn, wine, and oil, and honey, and of all the increase of the field; and the tithe of all *things* brought they in abundantly.

Positive

(2 Chronicles 32:28 KJV) Storehouses also for the increase of corn, and wine, and oil; and stalls for all manner of beasts, and cotes for flocks.

Positive

(Ezra 6:9 KJV) And that which they have need of, both young bullocks, and rams, and lambs, for the burnt offerings of the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine, and oil, according to the appointment of the priests which *are* at Jerusalem, let it be given them day by day without fail:

Positive

(Ezra 7:22 KJV) Unto an hundred talents of silver, and to an hundred measures of wheat, and to an hundred baths of wine, and to an hundred baths of oil, and salt without prescribing *how much*.

(Nehemiah 2:1 KJV) And it came to pass in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes the king, *that* wine *was* before him: and I took up the wine, and gave *it* unto the king. Now I had not been *beforetime* sad in his presence.

Neutral/Unknown

(Nehemiah 5:11 KJV) Restore, I pray you, to them, even this day, their lands, their vineyards, their oliveyards, and their houses, also the hundredth *part* of the money, and of the corn, the wine, and the oil, that ye exact of them.

Neutral/Unknown

(Nehemiah 5:15 KJV) But the former governors that *had been* before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

Neutral/Unknown

(Nehemiah 5:18 KJV) Now *that* which was prepared *for me* daily *was* one ox *and* six choice sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

Neutral/Unknown

(Nehemiah 10:37 KJV) And *that* we should bring the firstfruits of our dough, and our offerings, and the fruit of all manner of trees, of wine and of oil, unto the priests, to the chambers of the house of our God; and the tithes of our ground unto the Levites, that the same Levites might have the tithes in all the cities of our tillage.

Positive

(Nehemiah 10:39 KJV) For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the corn, of the new wine, and the oil, unto the chambers, where *are* the vessels of the sanctuary, and the priests that minister, and the porters, and the singers: and we will not forsake the house of our God.

Positive

(Nehemiah 13:5 KJV) And he had prepared for him a great chamber, where aforetime they laid the meat offerings, the frankincense, and the vessels, and the tithes of the corn, the new wine, and the oil, which was commanded *to be given* to the Levites, and the singers, and the porters; and the offerings of the priests.

Positive

(Nehemiah 13:12 KJV) Then brought all Judah the tithe of the corn and the new wine and the oil unto the treasuries.

Positive

(Nehemiah 13:15 KJV) In those days saw I in Judah *some* treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all *manner of* burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified *against them* in the day wherein they sold victuals.

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 1:7 KJV) And they gave them drink in vessels of gold, (the vessels being diverse one from

another,) and royal wine in abundance, according to the state of the king.

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 1:10 KJV) On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 5:6 KJV) And the king said unto Esther at the banquet of wine, What *is* thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: and what *is* thy request? even to the half of the kingdom it shall be performed.

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 7:2 KJV) And the king said again unto Esther on the second day at the banquet of wine, What *is* thy petition, queen Esther? and it shall be granted thee: and what *is* thy request? and it shall be performed, *even* to the half of the kingdom.

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 7:7 KJV) And the king arising from the banquet of wine in his wrath *went* into the palace garden: and Haman stood up to make request for his life to Esther the queen; for he saw that there was evil determined against him by the king.

Neutral/Unknown

(Esther 7:8 KJV) Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther *was*. Then said the king, Will he force the queen also before me in the house? As the word went out of the king's mouth, they covered Haman's face.

Neutral/Unknown

(Job 1:13 KJV) And there was a day when his sons and his daughters *were* eating and drinking wine in their eldest brother's house:

Neutral/Unknown

(Job 1:18 KJV) While he *was* yet speaking, there came also another, and said, Thy sons and thy daughters *were* eating and drinking wine in their eldest brother's house:

Neutral/Unknown

(Job 32:19 KJV) Behold, my belly is as wine which hath no vent; it is ready to burst like new bottles.

Neutral/Unknown

(Psalms 4:7 KJV) Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than in the time *that* their corn and their wine increased.

Neutral/Unknown

(Psalms 60:3 KJV) Thou hast shewed thy people hard things: thou hast made us to drink the wine of astonishment.

Neutral/Unknown

(Psalms 75:8 KJV) For in the hand of the LORD *there is* a cup, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring *them* out, *and* drink *them*.

Negative

(Psalms 78:65 KJV) Then the Lord awaked as one out of sleep, *and* like a mighty man that shouteth by reason of wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Psalms 104:15 KJV) And wine *that* maketh glad the heart of man, *and* oil to make *his* face to shine, and bread *which* strengtheneth man's heart.

Positive

(Proverbs 3:10 KJV) So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Positive

(Proverbs 4:17 KJV) For they eat the bread of wickedness, and drink the wine of violence.

Negative

(Proverbs 9:2 KJV) She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table

Positive

(Proverbs 9:5 KJV) Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled.

Positive

(Proverbs 20:1 KJV) Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.

Negative

(Proverbs 21:17 KJV) He that loveth pleasure *shall be* a poor man: he that loveth wine and oil shall not be rich.

Negative

(Proverbs 23:20 KJV) Be not among winebibbers; among riotous eaters of flesh:

Negative

(Proverbs 23:30 KJV) They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Proverbs 23:31 KJV) Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright.

Negative

(Proverbs 31:4 KJV) *It is* not for kings, O Lemuel, *it is* not for kings to drink wine; nor for princes strong drink:

Negative

(Proverbs 31:6 KJV) Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.

Negative

(Ecclesiastes 2:3 KJV) I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what *was* that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

Neutral/Unknown

(Ecclesiastes 9:7 KJV) Go thy way, eat thy bread with joy, and drink thy wine with a merry heart; for God now accepteth thy works.

Positive

(Ecclesiastes 10:19 KJV) A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all things.

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 1:2 KJV) Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth: for thy love *is* better than wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 1:4 KJV) Draw me, we will run after thee: the king hath brought me into his chambers: we will be glad and rejoice in thee, we will remember thy love more than wine: the upright love thee.

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 4:10 KJV) How fair is thy love, my sister, my spouse! how much better is thy love than wine! and the smell of thine ointments than all spices!

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 5:1 KJV) I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 7:9 KJV) And the roof of thy mouth like the best wine for my beloved, that goeth *down* sweetly, causing the lips of those that are asleep to speak.

Neutral/Unknown

(Song of Solomon 8:2 KJV) I would lead thee, *and* bring thee into my mother's house, *who* would instruct me: I would cause thee to drink of spiced wine of the juice of my pomegranate.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 1:22 KJV) Thy silver is become dross, thy wine mixed with water:

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 5:11 KJV) Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, *that* they may follow strong drink; that continue until night, *till* wine inflame them!

Negative

(Isaiah 5:12 KJV) And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their feasts: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 5:22 KJV) Woe unto *them that are* mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink:

Negative

(Isaiah 16:10 KJV) And gladness is taken away, and joy out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in *their* presses; I have made *their vintage* shouting to cease.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 22:13 KJV) And behold joy and gladness, slaying oxen, and killing sheep, eating flesh, and drinking wine: let us eat and drink; for to morrow we shall die.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 24:7 KJV) The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the merryhearted do sigh.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 24:9 KJV) They shall not drink wine with a song; strong drink shall be bitter to them that drink it.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 24:11 KJV) *There is* a crying for wine in the streets; all joy is darkened, the mirth of the land is gone.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 25:6 KJV) And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined.

Positive

(Isaiah 27:2 KJV) In that day sing ye unto her, A vineyard of red wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 28:1 KJV) Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty is a fading flower, which *are* on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine!

Negative

(Isaiah 28:7 KJV) But they also have erred through wine, and through strong drink are out of the way; the priest and the prophet have erred through strong drink, they are swallowed up of wine, they are out of the way through strong drink; they err in vision, they stumble *in* judgment.

Negative

(Isaiah 29:9 KJV) Stay yourselves, and wonder; cry ye out, and cry: they are drunken, but not with wine; they stagger, but not with strong drink.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 36:17 KJV) Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 49:26 KJV) And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD *am* thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

(Isaiah 51:21 KJV) Therefore hear now this, thou afflicted, and drunken, but not with wine:

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 55:1 KJV) Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

Positive

(Isaiah 56:12 KJV) Come ye, say they, I will fetch wine, and we will fill ourselves with strong drink; and to morrow shall be as this day, and much more abundant.

Neutral/Unknown

(Isaiah 62:8 KJV) The LORD hath sworn by his right hand, and by the arm of his strength, Surely I will no more give thy corn *to be* meat for thine enemies; and the sons of the stranger shall not drink thy wine, for the which thou hast laboured:

Positive

(Isaiah 65:8 KJV) Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and *one* saith, Destroy it not; for a blessing *is* in it: so will I do for my servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all.

Positive

(Jeremiah 13:12 KJV) Therefore thou shalt speak unto them this word; Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Every bottle shall be filled with wine: and they shall say unto thee, Do we not certainly know that every bottle shall be filled with wine?

Negative

(Jeremiah 23:9 KJV) Mine heart within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; I am like a drunken man, and like a man whom wine hath overcome, because of the LORD, and because of the words of his holiness.

Negative

(Jeremiah 25:15 KJV) For thus saith the LORD God of Israel unto me; Take the wine cup of this fury at my hand, and cause all the nations, to whom I send thee, to drink it.

Negative

(Jeremiah 31:12 KJV) Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.

Positive

(Jeremiah 35:2 KJV) Go unto the house of the Rechabites, and speak unto them, and bring them into the house of the LORD, into one of the chambers, and give them wine to drink.

Neutral/Unknown

(Jeremiah 35:5 KJV) And I set before the sons of the house of the Rechabites pots full of wine, and cups, and I said unto them, Drink ye wine.

Neutral/Unknown

(Jeremiah 35:6 KJV) But they said, We will drink no wine: for Jonadab the son of Rechab our father

commanded us, saying, Ye shall drink no wine, *neither* ye, nor your sons for ever:

(Jeremiah 35:8 KJV) Thus have we obeyed the voice of Jonadab the son of Rechab our father in all that he hath charged us, to drink no wine all our days, we, our wives, our sons, nor our daughters;

(Jeremiah 35:14 KJV) The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but obey their father's commandment: notwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye hearkened not unto me.

(Jeremiah 40:10 KJV) As for me, behold, I will dwell at Mizpah to serve the Chaldeans, which will come unto us: but ye, gather ye wine, and summer fruits, and oil, and put *them* in your vessels, and dwell in your cities that ye have taken.

(Jeremiah 40:12 KJV) Even all the Jews returned out of all places whither they were driven, and came to the land of Judah, to Gedaliah, unto Mizpah, and gathered wine and summer fruits very much.

(Jeremiah 48:33 KJV) And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; *their* shouting *shall* be no shouting.

(Jeremiah 51:7 KJV) Babylon *hath been* a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

Negative

(Lamentations 2:12 KJV) They say to their mothers, Where is corn and wine? when they swooned as the wounded in the streets of the city, when their soul was poured out into their mothers' bosom.

Neutral/Unknown

(Ezekiel 27:18 KJV) Damascus was thy merchant in the multitude of the wares of thy making, for the multitude of all riches; in the wine of Helbon, and white wool.

Neutral/Unknown

(Ezekiel 44:21 KJV) Neither shall any priest drink wine, when they enter into the inner court.

Neutral/Unknown

(Daniel 1:5 KJV) And the king appointed them a daily provision of the king's meat, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof they might stand before the king.

Negative

(Daniel 1:8 KJV) But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

Negative

(Daniel 1:16 KJV) Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse.

Negative

(Daniel 5:1 KJV) Belshazzar the king made a great feast to a thousand of his lords, and drank wine before the thousand.

(Daniel 5:2 KJV) Belshazzar, whiles he tasted the wine, commanded to bring the golden and silver vessels which his father Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple which *was* in Jerusalem; that the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, might drink therein.

Neutral/Unknown

(Daniel 10:3 KJV) I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

Neutral/Unknown

(Hosea 2:8 KJV) For she did not know that I gave her corn, and wine, and oil, and multiplied her silver and gold, *which* they prepared for Baal.

Positive

(Hosea 2:9 KJV) Therefore will I return, and take away my corn in the time thereof, and my wine in the season thereof, and will recover my wool and my flax *given* to cover her nakedness.

Positive

(Hosea 2:22 KJV) And the earth shall hear the corn, and the wine, and the oil; and they shall hear Jezreel.

Positive

(Hosea 3:1 KJV) Then said the LORD unto me, Go yet, love a woman beloved of *her* friend, yet an adulteress, according to the love of the LORD toward the children of Israel, who look to other gods, and love flagons of wine.

Negative

(Hosea 4:11 KJV) Whoredom and wine and new wine take away the heart.

Negative

(Hosea 7:5 KJV) In the day of our king the princes have made *him* sick with bottles of wine; he stretched out his hand with scorners.

Negative

(Hosea 7:14 KJV) And they have not cried unto me with their heart, when they howled upon their beds: they assemble themselves for corn and wine, *and* they rebel against me.

Neutral/Unknown

(Hosea 9:2 KJV) The floor and the winepress shall not feed them, and the new wine shall fail in her.

Neutral/Unknown

(Hosea 9:4 KJV) They shall not offer wine *offerings* to the LORD, neither shall they be pleasing unto him: their sacrifices *shall be* unto them as the bread of mourners; all that eat thereof shall be polluted: for their bread for their soul shall not come into the house of the LORD.

Neutral/Unknown

(Hosea 14:7 KJV) They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive

as the corn, and grow as the vine: the scent thereof shall be as the wine of Lebanon.

Neutral/Unknown

(Joel 1:5 KJV) Awake, ye drunkards, and weep; and howl, all ye drinkers of wine, because of the new wine; for it is cut off from your mouth.

Negative

(Joel 1:10 KJV) The field is wasted, the land mourneth; for the corn is wasted: the new wine is dried up, the oil languisheth.

Neutral/Unknown

(Joel 2:19 KJV) Yea, the LORD will answer and say unto his people, Behold, I will send you corn, and wine, and oil, and ye shall be satisfied therewith: and I will no more make you a reproach among the heathen:

Positive

(Joel 2:24 KJV) And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the fats shall overflow with wine and oil.

Positive

(Joel 3:3 KJV) And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

Neutral/Unknown

(Joel 3:18 KJV) And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Positive

(Amos 2:8 KJV) And they lay *themselves* down upon clothes laid to pledge by every altar, and they drink the wine of the condemned *in* the house of their god.

Negative

(Amos 2:12 KJV) But ye gave the Nazarites wine to drink; and commanded the prophets, saying, Prophesy not.

(Amos 5:11 KJV) Forasmuch therefore as your treading *is* upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them.

(Amos 6:6 KJV) That drink wine in bowls, and anoint themselves with the chief ointments: but they are not grieved for the affliction of Joseph.

(Amos 9:13 KJV) Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

(Amos 9:14 KJV) And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit *them;* and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

Positive

(Micah 2:11 KJV) If a man walking in the spirit and falsehood do lie, *saying*, I will prophesy unto thee of wine and of strong drink; he shall even be the prophet of this people.

Neutral/Unknown

(Micah 6:15 KJV) Thou shalt sow, but thou shalt not reap; thou shalt tread the olives, but thou shalt not anoint thee with oil; and sweet wine, but shalt not drink wine.

(Habakkuk 2:5 KJV) Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, *he is* a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and *is* as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

(Haggai 1:11 KJV) And I called for a drought upon the land, and upon the mountains, and upon the corn, and upon the new wine, and upon the oil, and upon that which the ground bringeth forth, and upon men, and upon cattle, and upon all the labour of the hands.

(Mark 15:23 KJV) And they gave him to drink wine mingled with myrrh: but he received it not.

(Luke 1:15 KJV) For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.

(Luke 5:37 KJV) And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.
